Holiday Plants in the Home
It's that time again - ly drain (no dripping from plant to decorate the home, you'll want it perky and weeks at least, So here are a few tips that may help. The two biggest factors
that will be issues are overwatering and dry inside radiction! You can kil more plants by over-water-
ng than by rarely waterng; they just don't like sitting in water-logged soil if they're designed for life beathe, and if the air they live in is too dry, they can't uck in enough moisture or their good health, and moisture out of them to boot. To address the air humidity, set the plants lovely glass bowl filled with pebbles, with water up to, but not touching, the bottom of the pot.
Next, we need
the newly purchased or gifted plant. Due to the season, they come in a decouter layer, wrapped in ribbon. They are moving from greenhouses in optimum homes with varying light conditions, humidity levels, and temperature variin bright light, but ideally not in a window. Heat from the sun hitting the glass
will shorten the life of the will shorten the life of the evel daily at first so you can establish a watering chedule. After a few days soil will be fairly dry, and may even start to pull way from the edge of the pot. It this is the case, repackaging, run about a cup of water through the grow
y drain (no dripping fro
the bottom) before you re-
place it into the foil basket.
Unless the growing mediUnless the growing medi-
um is very thin and porous, you shouldn't need to wa-
ter more than once a week, perhaps only every other
week. week.

save. Like it was just noted, the growing medium in
greenhouse grown plants greenhouse grown plants
is usually not suited for is usualiy not suited for plants. You may be able to
successfully keep plants successfully keep plants
alive in pots, but you need alive in pots, but you need
to give them better soil to work with. Poinsettias are well-known for having
lousy long-term survival, lousy long-term survival,
but it's due more to what they were grown in at the greenhouse. Cheap, easy,
and fast kind of describes the drive for poinsettia
growth by commercial growers, so if you want
your your baby poinsettia to
survive, give it something worth wiggling its roots in. Do you have a Christmas cactus that survived
from last year? Christmas from last year? Christmas
cactus and poinsettias can cactus and poinsettias can
stay in pots or be planted
outsid in protected outside in protected areas.
Planting in the ground in Planting in the ground in
a protected area means a protected area means
southern exposure; these plants can freeze, so wait till spring for this project.
If repotting needs to be done, plant them in loose
soil, with a lot of organic soint with a lot of organic they can drain. The cactus,
like poinsettias, set blooms according to light cycles, and need total darkness for
$10-12$ hours a day for 10-12 hours a day for
blooming. The cactus needs this light blockage beginning about September 1 ,
and the poinsettia and the poinsettia about
October 1 for blooming at Christmas. Once the buds form on the cactus, or the
poinsettia, they can be
treated to your home's reg in the ground, you may
want to pinch it back a few times during the year to have it brangh more. Poin-
settias will grow in this settias will grow in this

they will need that darkness to bloom, so keep them away from the porch
lights or plan on coverin lights or plan on covering
them with something to give them total darkness. Gloxinias and cyclamen
are popular this time are popular this time of

soil mix for these. Kalanchoe and Christmas cactus take a sandier soil. They
also need less waterin also need less watering
than most of the holiday group. Bromeliads take their liquids in the cup,

get. Bulbs, like the narcissus

ally naturalizes, and the amaryllis nearly always
does. Leave the green stuff, but you can cut the
flower stem off. A light bulb fertilizer application during the year will be enough to take care of their needs. You can also just
plant them in the pot int the flower bed, and dig up the pot next winter to

AUSTIN - Texas has
its lowest unemployment rate in more than 42 years.
The Texas Workforce Commission on Nov. 16
announced that Texas' seaannounced that Texas sea
sonally adjusted unemployment rate fell to 3.7 percent in October, down
from 3.8 percent the prior from 3.8 percent the prior

It is the lowest level of unemployment the state has seen since January 1976. The Texas economy added 32,300 seasonally adjusted non-farm jobs in
